As you may know, **Festival of Friends** is **Mississauga Festival Choir's (MFC)** annual massed choir event. Multiple choirs from Mississauga and Toronto join together to raise money for a local charity, with this year's proceeds going to Alzheimer Society Peel. This will be our 10th Festival of Friends concert, and over the years we've raised over \$25,000 for local charities. We sing several massed numbers, and each choir performs two or three solo pieces as well. This year award-winning recording artist and Jazz.FM91 radio host **Heather Bambrick** will be our emcee, and she'll also perform in one of the numbers.

This day is devoted to forging friendships with other local choirs as we rehearse and dine together before the concert, where we join in song to raise funds for a local charity. This is an event we look forward to each year and of which we are quite proud.

This year Mississauga Festival Choir will be joined by seven other choirs:
